



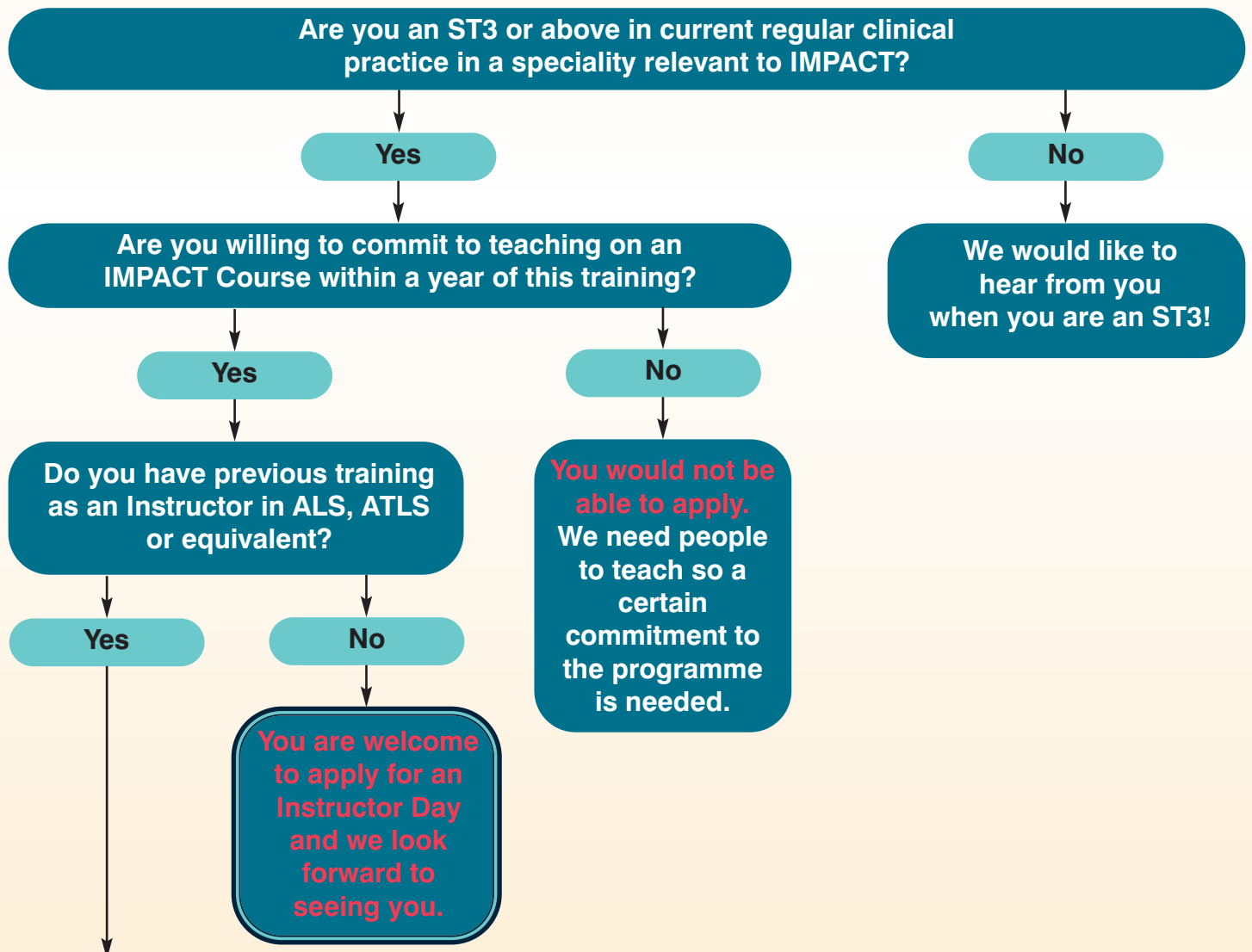
ELIGIBILITY TO ATTEND AN IMPACT INSTRUCTOR DAY

The IMPACT administration is very keen to encourage enthusiasts to participate in teaching the programme. IMPACT instructor days are arranged and are intended to do two things:

- to enhance education skills to those who may not otherwise had the opportunity to learn them and
- to familiarise potential instructors with the course content

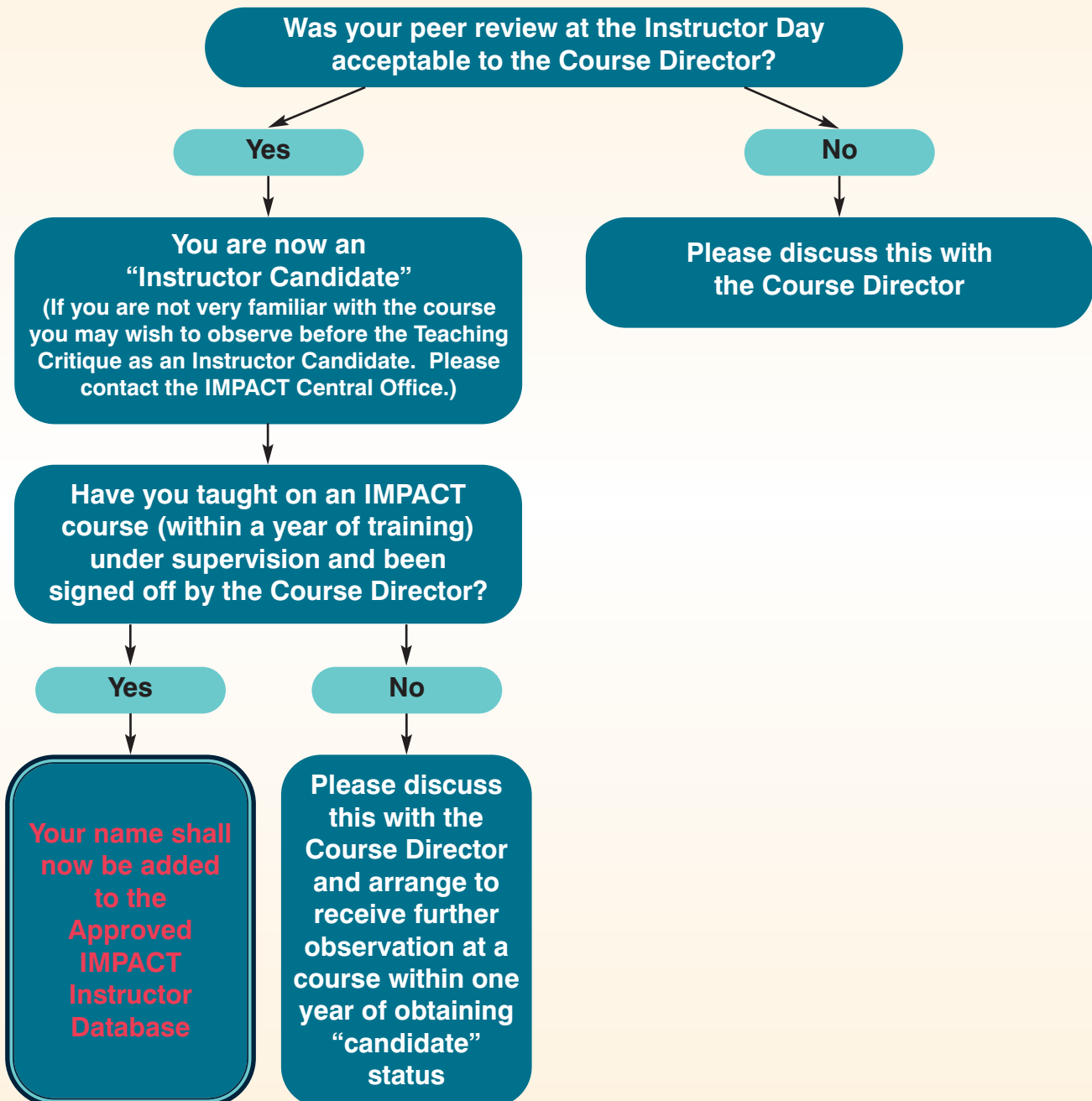
In order to maintain the standard of IMPACT... which is aimed at ST1 trainees in medicine, certain criteria must be fulfilled. The chart below is intended to explain the instructor selection process. If you feel that any aspect of this is unclear please contact admin@impactmedical.org for advice.

How to get a place on an IMPACT instructor day.



You can teach IMPACT with the consent of the Course Director although you may wish to attend an IMPACT instructor day to become more familiar with IMPACT materials. Make sure you are familiar with the materials and standards required before teaching on your first course where you will be an "instructor candidate." Sign off by the course director after satisfactory teaching on your first IMPACT course will be required before your name will be added to the instructor database.

How to progress from candidate to approved instructor on IMPACT:



To retain your status as an approved IMPACT instructor.

To remain on the Approved Instructor Database you will be required to teach on a minimum of one IMPACT Course over a period of two years.

(In future Certificates will be issued with an expiry date and if you have not taught on a minimum of one course over two years, then the certificate will not be re-issued).
